By answering these questions, you will be able to identify the key ideas and events from that section of the story of Scripture. We've included a list of the main supporting characters for you! (Feel free to use bullet points to answer these questions.)

Once you have answered those three questions, combine your answers into a 5–7 sentence summary that flows in chronological order of events. After you have finished all 7 summaries, you can put them together to form a complete summary of the story of Scripture in your own words!
